The following professional position(s) are being considered:

Math Tutor – Fairmont Catholic P17 10 04 10

The math tutor will tutor one hour daily for four days a week at a time mutually determined by the Title I Director and the Principal. Elementary Education certification required. Preference will be given to those who have experience with working with Fairmont Catholic students and the school's curriculum and expectations.

Reading Tutor – Fairmont Catholic P17 10 04 11

The reading tutor will tutor one hour daily for four days a week at a time mutually determined by the Title I Director and the Principal. Elementary Education certification required. Preference will be given to those who have experience with working with Fairmont Catholic students and the school's curriculum and expectations.

Reading/Math Tutor – Stepping Stones P17 10 04 12

The reading/math tutor will tutor one hour daily for four days a week following the Marion County School Calendar at a time that will be mutually determined by the Stepping Stones personnel and the Title I Director. The tutor must have a valid WV teaching certificate that includes Reading Specialist/Remedial Reading Authorization and preferably math certification. Preference will be given to those having tutoring experience with institutional students.

Marion County Youth Report Center – Evening Program P17 10 04 13

The tutor for the evening program will provide tutoring and credit recovery assistance and must be secondary certified with preferably Alternative Education certification and experience. The tutor will work one to one and a half hour per evening/afternoon for 3-4 days a week. The schedule will be mutually developed by the Title I Director and the Youth Report Center Director.

After School Tutor - Fairview Elementary P17 10 04 14

Tutor must have an elementary education certification and will provide supplemental reading and math instruction for approximately one hour per day for four days per week according to a schedule approved by the principal and Title I Director.

Salary: As per 2015-16 Marion County Schools pay scale

Appointment will be made in accordance with West Virginia school law.
